



The Shanklin Fund for Seniors Program is for Frederick

County residents **age 65 or older** on a limited income. This fund assists area seniors in covering expenses associated with annual well-care visits and necessary vaccinations for their companion animal at participating Frederick County veterinary clinics.

The fund grants up to \$100/year to qualifying seniors. Available services and coverage rates are listed below. Any charges greater than the listed coverage values are the responsibility of the program participant.

- > Office visit (\$45)
- > Rabies vaccine (\$19)
- > Distemper vaccine (\$23)
- > Bordatella vaccine (\$23)
- > Canine Lepto vaccine (\$16)
- > Feline Leukemia vaccine (\$23)
- > Lyme Disease vaccine (\$30)

The maximum income for program participation is \$26,000 for a household of one; \$35,000 for a household of two; and \$43,000 for a household of three or more. Income from all household occupants is taken into consideration to determine the grant award.
