What does KINDness stand for?

KIND stands for Kids In Nature's Defense, and is a program of the National Association of Humane and Environmental Education (NAHEE), the youth education division of the Humane Society of the United States (HSUS). Although our names are similar, the Frederick County Humane Society is an independent not-for-profit organization. We receive no government funding, nor do we have a "parent" organization.

Can my child volunteer at the Humane Society?

All Humane Society volunteers must be at least 15 years of age. The KINDness Club programs are designed to give younger kids the opportunity to learn about animals and help the Humane Society. For example, the KINDness Club kids have their own booth at the annual Walk-N-Wag event in Baker Park.

Who coordinates the KINDness club?

The KINDness Club is coordinated by Humane Society volunteers. If you're interested in helping with future programs, please ask for a volunteer application!

What types of programs has the KINDness Club been involved with?

Recent programs included visiting and learning about animal rescue groups (guinea pigs, house rabbits, iguanas, apacacs, horses, wildlife, farm animals, etc.), touring the animal shelter in Frederick County, visits from the Beagle Brigade and Guiding Eyes for the Blind, bird watching, touring a fish hatchery, a nature hike, and getting up close and personal with snakes!
