#### Emergency Pet Food Bank

FCHS offers temporary assistance to our residents who cannot afford to feed their pets.

#### Rabies and Microchip Clinics

Four times a year, the FCHS holds low-cost rabies vaccination and microchipping clinics.

### Quick Fix for Cats

FCHS sponsors the Quick Fix for Cats clinics twice a year, offering spay/neuter services at a reduced fee.

# Pet Over Population (POP)

FCHS has partnered with local vets to offer reduced fee spay/neuter services to low-income residents.
